

Leading innovator Vita 34 expands business

Biotech company from Leipzig accompanies set-up of stem cell bank in Yinchuan

Leipzig, October 20, 2016 - Vita 34 and the Chinese technology company AVIC Biology plan to set up a stem cell bank in Yinchuan together according to German quality standards. The collaboration aims at setting up a laboratory for the preparation and cryo-preservation of stem cells from umbilical cord blood. The laboratory is to comply with the highest medical quality standards and will provide the possibility of private storage for patients and their family members as well as the option of public donation.

Vita 34 delivers the complete expertise for establishing the stem cell bank, including not only technical equipment and assistance, but also the training of the local employees.
